THE WINERY

Founded in the early 2000s by Josep Grau upon a base of Garnacha and Mazuelo (Carignan) vines between 40 and 100 years of age in the traditional Priorat villages of Marçà, Capçanes and Falset. Llicorella, chalk and clay terroirs exist side by side, allowing for subtle interplay between boldness and minerality. Fermentation takes place in cement vats. Oak influence is minimal, including the exclusive use of oak ovals and puncheons artisanally produced by Stockinger in Vienna.

THE WINE

Made from Garnacha and a small percentage of Samsó (Carignan), from vines averaging 30 years old grown on clay and granite soils. From 2016, aging takes place exclusively in cement vats to feature the fresh fruit, reminiscent of ripe cherries. Moderately full-bodied with balanced tannins, lingering minerality and smoke on the finish.

- Grapes:** 80% Garnacha and 20% Samsó.
Vineyards: Vines are between 40 and 100 years of age.
Winemaking: Aged in various sized French oak barrique.
