THE WINERY

K5 Argiñano is a modern vineyard estate located on a hillside near the Basque village of Aia at 1000 feet above sea level overlooking the Cantabrian seaports of Zarautz and Orío. Founded in 2005 by Spanish celebrity chef Karlos Argiñano and four partners, the objective is to showcase the noble and age worthy quality of the indigenous Hondarrabi Zuri and its ability to produce extractive, super-dry, mineralic whites worthy of the finest table.

THE WINE

Fifteen acres of Hondarrabi Zuri (also spelled *Hondarribi Zuri*) are dry farmed in slate and granite soils with yields limited to under two kilos per vine. Uhin Berdea is a selection from younger vines, bottled in February following several months' aging on the fine lees.

30,000 bottles were produced from the excellent 2014 vintage.

DETAILS OF WINEMAKING & VITICULTURE

Grapes: 100% Hondarrabi Zuri

Vineyards: 15 hectares of 100% Hondarrabi-Zuri grapes planted on trellis framework around 300m above sea level. Soil composed of granite, chalk, limestone and gray shale.

Winemaking: Grapes from a single estate. Manual selection of grapes, cold pre-fermentation maceration for 8 hours at 61oF, followed by fermentation in small stainless steel tanks with selected yeasts. Aged 5 months on its lees in stainless steel tanks at controlled temperatures.

Alcohol: 11%
