THE WINERY

Morgadío is the easternmost inland estate in D.O. Rías Baixas, located in the subdistrict of Condado do Tea. Albariño's revelation as one of the wine world's noble white varieties is due in large part to work done at this property from the mid '80s to the mid '90s.

THE WINE

Intense and elegant with tropical fruit and kiwi complementing granitic minerality. Made from free-run juice, a well structured, dry Albariño with a long finish.

IN THE PRESS

Peach aromas include a note of stone-fruit pit, while citrus is the other standout scent on an elegant nose. This wine is citrusy in feel, with good body and clarity. Flavors of orange and ripe grapefruit finish in fresh, clean fashion.

- Grapes:** 100% Albariño
- Vineyards:** 30 hectares - southern exposure and soil of brilliantly-reflective granite sand serve to maximize the Albariño's concentration.
- Winemaking:** Fermentation for 15 days at 61°F.
- Winemaker:** Alejandra Nores
- Alcohol:** 12.5%
