THE WINERY

The Montaña family heritage dates to the late 19th century and the beginnings of modern Rioja. The family estate consists of 270 acres of traditional vineyard sites in the best districts of the Rioja Alta and Rioja Alavesa, and includes an unusually high percentage of the scarce, indigenous Graciano variety.

THE WINE

97% Tempranillo and 3% Graciano aged 12 months in seasoned French oak. Spice and leather complement the deep blackberry fruit and ferrous minerality of Rioja's red soils. Mouth-filling yet fresh, with the structure for improving in bottle for a number of years.

DETAILS OF WINEMAKING & VITICULTURE

Grapes: 97% Tempranillo, 3% Graciano

Vineyards: Oscar Montaña directs a vineyard estate comprising over 270 acres of prime sites in the Rioja Alta and Alavesa districts. The Montaña vineyards boast a high average vine age, many vines dating to the immediate post-phylloxera period and including significant acreage of the rare Graciano.

Winemaking: Aged 12 months in American and French oak barriques.

Alcohol: 13%



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
